

Tomaree Lodge

Aboriginal heritage and history

Tomaree Lodge is a place of local and state significance and has greatly contributed to the landscape and story of Port Stephens on Worimi Country.

Tomaree Lodge is located on Worimi Country at the base of Tomaree Headland.

The adjoining Tomaree National Park is understood to have provided a range of resources for the Worimi People, including food, medicines and shelter.

The ancient landscape of Tomaree Headland is part of the cultural knowledge and 'Dreaming' stories of Worimi People.

A walk along the beaches of Tomaree National Park is to trace the ancient routes travelled by Worimi people as they ventured north and south through their Country.

It is important the future use of Tomaree Lodge respects and reflects the history of Tomaree Headland and Tomaree National Park as places of local Aboriginal significance.
