ABOUT HOW THE QUALITY ASSURANCE FRAMEWORK (QAF) WILL SUPPORT PRACTITIONERS BY PROVIDING THEM WITH A MORE COMPREHENSIVE PICTURE OF WHAT IS HAPPENING IN A CHILD OR YOUNG PERSON'S LIFE.

Under the Permanency Support Program we're changing how we fund and deliver services to vulnerable children. The QAF is designed to improve the outcomes for each child in statutory out-of-home care.

The way forward:

Information on safety, permanency and wellbeing will be collected from various sources including: children, young people, carers, FACS, NGOs, Health, Education and Justice.
