## **Family Victims** Travel expenses declaration form

A family victim is eligible to claim up to \$5,000 for their immediate needs, and up to \$5,000 for justice-related expenses, incurred as a direct result of the act of violence. This may cover costs incurred as a result of attending a funeral, criminal or coronial proceedings, and justice related meetings.

### Travel - Day

If you need to travel for a funeral or justicerelated event you may receive an allowance for meals, snacks and incidentals. The allowance is based on the NSW Crown Employees Meal, Travelling and other Allowances rates.

In addition to this allowance, receipts for parking, public transport and taxi may also be considered.

### Travel - Overnight

If you need to travel a long distance to attend a funeral or justice-related event you may receive an allowance based on the NSW Crown
